

Some, often younger, women were ready to challenge these norms, so the women's movement, stagnant since women got the vote, enjoyed a resurgence or second wave.

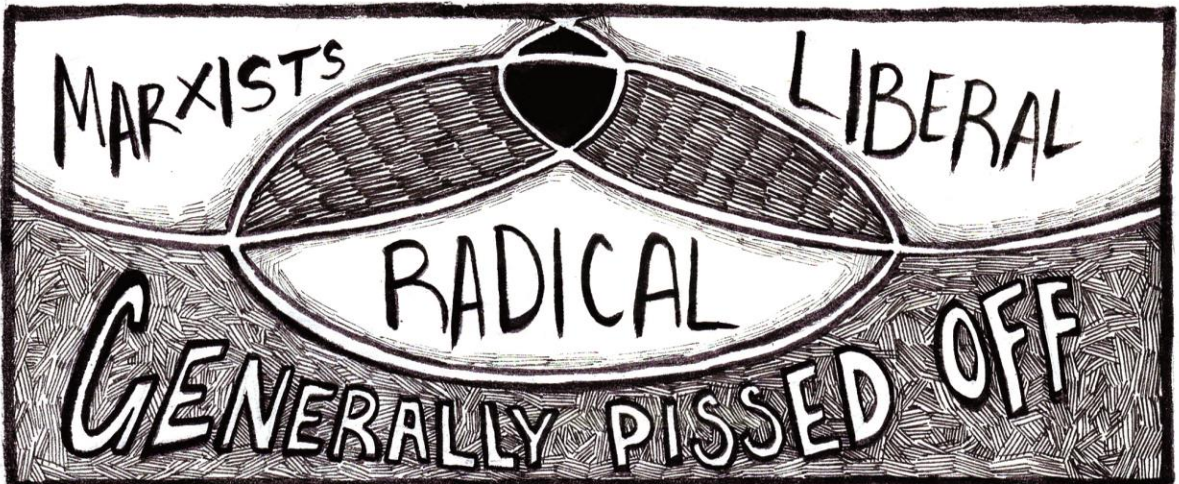


Whilst all in the movement wanted greater equality, different women had different ideas how to achieve this.
